

Extruded Polystyrene Foam Association (XPSA) Announces Direct to Deck Licensing Program

WASHINGTON, D.C. (August 11, 2015) – The Extruded Polystyrene Foam Association (XPSA) is transitioning the Direct to Deck Program from the American Chemistry Counsel (ACC) where the program originated in 2006.

The Direct Deck program is a file sharing collaborative effort to strengthen industry data for manufactures of extruded polystyrene (XPS) and expanded polystyrene (EPS) foam market. To gain access, XPSA grants a non-exclusive, non-transferable license for the use of the required research and data regarding the fire performance of polystyrene foam insulation in the direct-deck roof applications.

Direct to Deck licensing is in conjunction with the International Code Council – Evaluation Service (ICC-ES) and EPS Industry Alliance (EPSIA) as an information sharing partnership. The program will continue to be available to companies and manufactures in the XPS and EPS foam market.
